
I would like to thank you once again for the generous gift of £1350 towards Lily Mae's Helping Hands project.

## Lily Mai's Garden

3 year old from Grays

**Lily Mai** has a number of conditions including Vein of Galen malformation, Hydrocephalus and Cerebral Palsy. She needs 24/7 care and uses a wheelchair. Since moving into the property Lily's parents had cleared back overgrowth and installed a fence but needed help creating an area which was accessible and suitable for Lily Mai.

Volunteers from **Experian** transformed the garden in just two days. After clearing a low wall and levelling the ground they installed a deck, giving wheelchair access to the garden and providing the family an area to use together. They created raised beds for sensory planting and secured a swing for Lily and her sister to use, with added safety matting. The team also prepared the ground and laid turf on a large section of the garden, making it easier to maintain and use. This means Lily can now access the garden in her chair, relax on her swing and spend time with the family on the deck
